### **GUIDED GROUP TOURS**

Groups of ten or more are eligible for a group admission rate of \$16 (adults) and \$13 (Seniors and Students). Guided tours are available. Guides can accommodate up to 25 people at a time. A maximum of 15 people for ESL groups is recommended. Tours are approximately 60 minutes long.

The cost per guide is \$75 (\$150 outside public hours) plus tax.

Guided tours offered by our curators, when available, are \$200 (\$250 outside public hours) plus tax.

From downtown, take 4th, 10th or 16th Avenue west to UBC. From the airport, take SW Marine Drive or 41st Avenue to UBC.


### **BY TRANSIT**

For bus routes to UBC, contact
Translink at 604-953-3333 or
translink.ca. From UBC bus loop,
catch either the C18 (faster) or C20
(scenic) campus shuttle to MOA, one
of which leaves every 15 minutes. Or
walk north 10 minutes to NW Marine
Drive. MOA is on the north side of the
street.

### PARKING

Parking is available in front of the museum and across the street from MOA at the Rose Garden Parkade. Parking rates are \$3.50 an hour. (Note: parking rates are subject to change.) Bike racks are available near the Museum's entrance.
